- On the "Edit Profile" page, enter the following settings
 - User Role for Fujitsu Data e-TRUST
 - Both "User Role" and "User ID" are required fields
 - The User ID default value is the account's Object ID
 - The User ID should be within 100 characters and can include letters, numbers, underscores (_), hyphens (-), @, and periods (.). Text strings starting with _system_ or _trust_ are not allowed.
 - Agent1 Role for Fujitsu Data e-TRUST
 - Select the appropriate role from admin/user/ tseal admin/tseal agent/tseal user
 - Set roles for Agent 1 to Agent 10 in the same way
 - The default values for Agent1 Agent4 are as follows:
 - Role: admin and tseal user
 - ID: sandbox001 sandbox004
 - The ID should be within 50 characters and can include letters, numbers and hyphens (-). Character strings contain underscore (_) are not allowed.
- When the settings are complete, click the "Continue" button at the bottom of the page.
 - The edit process is now complete
 - The edit screen will close automatically
